



**From 20<sup>th</sup> June, we will be returning to the traditional form of receiving Communion, though it will be only in one kind at this time.**

1. Communion will be in one kind only (bread)
2. Face coverings must be worn until stationary at the dais
3. Communicants will be instructed by Stewards/Churchwarden when it is their turn to go up to the dais
4. Social distancing must be maintained at all times while at the dais and moving to and from seats
5. The Priest will sanitise their hands before touching the host and will wear a visor while giving communion
6. You are invited to come up to the dais to receive a blessing, which will be socially distanced. The Priest will not place their hand on your head
7. Once you have received the host, please replace your mask and return to your seat

The Priest will give these instructions during the service to remind everyone of the protocols.
