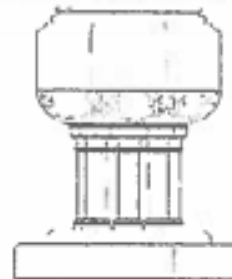

Look at the picture of St Margaret in the corner of the Lady Chapel.

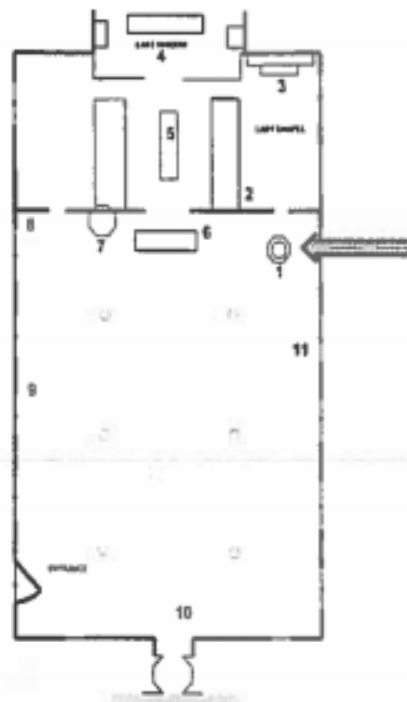

7 PULPIT

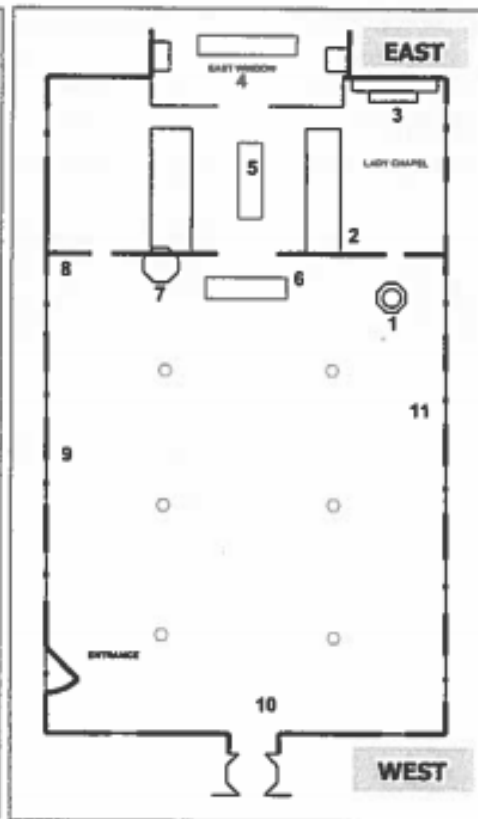
The Pulpit is used by preachers to give their sermons or talks. Above the Pulpit is a wooden sounding-board.

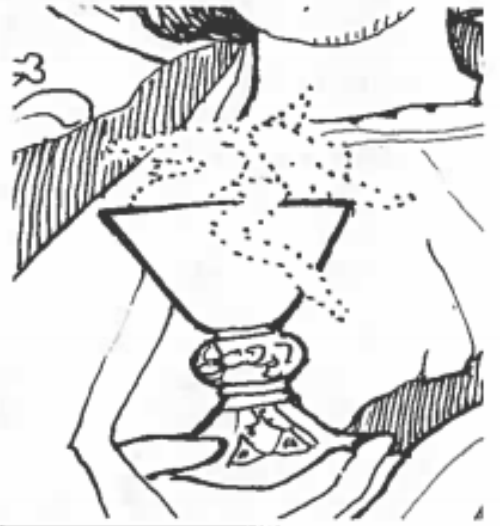
