

EDRIC ALFRED BAKER

Birth:

Son of Frank J. and Sarah A. Baker, of 18, Caterham Rd., Lewisham.
Frank became a Lay Clerk at St Margaret's Church, Lee.

In January 1918 St Margaret's Parish Magazine writes:-

*"Deep sympathy will be felt for Mr F.T. Baker one of our voluntary choirmen and his wife at the loss of their only son in the Cambrai fighting where he was reputed to have died "like a hero"
There is a vacancy for a heavy base in the choir."*

**Private, BAKER, EDRIC ALFRED, Service Number SR/03975.
Enlisted to the Army Service Corps, then commissioned into the King's Own (Royal Lancaster Regiment).
Died 30/11/1917, Aged 28. TYNE COT MEMORIAL [Panel 160]
(Belgium).**
