

HARRY BRAIN

Birth: 31st August 1898. Lewisham, London

He was the eldest son of Harry Sidney and Florence Sarah of Manor Lane Lee and, at one time, of 18 Dacre Houses, Dacre Park Lee. He had 6 Siblings.

His father, also Harry, died in France in 1915 and is buried in the Wimereux Communal Cemetery. His mother and siblings are buried in Hither Green Cemetery, Lewisham.

Lance Corporal HARRY BRAIN, Service Number S/1872. 7th Bn. Royal Sussex Regiment

Killed in Action on 7 July 1916 aged 17 years. He was buried at Serre Road Cemetery no. 2 [Plot XV.B.5] (France)

War Service:

L/Corporal Harry Brain served with the British Expeditionary Force in the 7th Battalion of the Royal Sussex Regiment.

War Service:

*Gunner Harry Sidney Brain served 1st with the 10th Squadron, 3rd Imperial Yeomanry Volunteers in the 2nd Boer War.
In WWI he served with the Royal Garrison Artillery.*

He died on 15 April 1915, aged 35, in No. 14 Stationary Hospital Boulogne. He is buried in the Wimereux communal Cemetery, Nord-pas-de-Calais, [Plot 1.E.28A] (France).
